NURSERY ACTIVITIES

Mushrooms Making



Mushrooms are a type of fungus, they grow in the ground, some are edible and can be eaten as food. They can come in different shapes and colors and have a "cap" and a "stem" as their main parts.

Dussehra toran.

Dussehra, a time for celebrating the victory of good over evil, involves the creation of colourful torans made from rice corn, mango leaves, marigolds and various wild flowers.

Torans are used to adorn homes, buildings, vehicles, and various household items, symbolizing the presence of the goddess Lakshmi.





The meaning of CROWN is a reward of victory or mark of honor or a title representing a sports championship. It can also mean something that imparts honor, splendor, or finish.

This activity is typically designed to teach basic concepts like shapes, colors, cutting skills and fine motor coordination and also introducing the idea of royalty and symbolism associated with the crown.

Ladybug Making

The national flag of India called Tiranga, is a horizontal rectangular tricolour flag, the colours being of India Saffron, White and India green with the Ashoka Chakra, a 24 spoke wheel, in navy blue at its centre. In India the term tricolour almost always refers to the Indian national flag.
